

#### Government Affairs Update By Tim Walton, Walton External Affairs

Legislative Update: As previously reported, the Legislature returned to the Statehouse on May 2nd where they considered twenty Gubernatorial Vetoes. Of those, eleven were overridden and nine sustained. However, probably one of the most highly anticipated decisions of the day never happened. All eyes were on Augusta, as the news media, political pundits, special interest groups and curious citizens alike watched intently, waiting to hear when the lawmakers would come back to deal with the pending bills that remained. That decision never surfaced and thus, once again, they left the building with the timeline of their return still uncertain. Although nothing should be counted for certain at this point with regards to when a special session will be scheduled, or even if one will occur at all, the fact there are still a number of important bills left on the table lends to a strong likelihood the Legislature will return to the Capitol at some point to work these issues. Stay tuned.

Election 2018: If you are eligible and planning to vote in Maine's June 12th primary election, you will be casting your vote for candidates for the first time here in Maine using a new system called "Ranked-Choice-Voting". Although many of you have probably heard about this new voting process, you may still have questions or would like to learn more. That said, the Secretary of State has posted an informational page on its website, where you can learn more about the ranked-choice-voting process, including Frequently Asked Questions and sample ballots.
